Transport Options

By Flight:

Liechtenstein does not have its own airport. The nearest major airport is Zurich Airport (ZRH) in Switzerland, which is about 130 km (approximately 2 hours by car) from Vaduz. From the airport, you can take a train, bus, or rent a car to reach Vaduz.

By Train:

Liechtenstein does not have a direct train connection, but the Swiss railway (SBB) offers regular service to Sargans or Buchs in Switzerland, and Feldkirch in Austria. From these towns, you can take a bus to Vaduz.

- From Zurich Airport, you can take a train to Sargans (approximately 1 hour) and then take Bus 11 (LIEmobil) to Vaduz (approximately 30 minutes).

By Bus:

- The LIEmobil bus company provides public transportation within Liechtenstein and connects it to Switzerland and Austria. Bus 11 is the most useful for travelers, as it runs along the Rhine River valley, passing through most of Liechtenstein's towns, including Vaduz.

By Car:

If you're driving, you can reach Vaduz from Switzerland or Austria. From Zurich, it's about a 1.5-hour drive along the A3 and A13 motorways. If coming from Austria, you can take the A14 motorway.

Travel Itinerary

12:00 PM - Arrival in Vaduz
